# Bright Hills History

The Barony of Bright Hills is the 13<sup>th</sup> Barony in the Kingdom of Atlantia. It held its first Investiture on February 12, 1994 (A.S. 28) at the home of Master Chirhart Blackstar and Mistress Jeanne Tennur de Bec, when inclement weather prevented it to be held at its original site.

## *Charter for the Order of St Barbara:*

1. *The Order of St Barbara is to be a polling Order.*
2. *Only members of the Barony who have been involved with the Barony for 10 years or more are eligible for this Award.*
3. *The Baron/Baroness may not induct anyone into the Order unless the Order is in agreement.*
4. *At least 2/3rds of the Order must agree before someone may be inducted into this Order.*
5. *In case of a tie vote for a candidate, the Principal of the Order has the right to a second vote to break the tie.*

As Saint Barbara is the patron of builders and, as those who have served this Barony for many years have helped to build it into the Great Barony that it is, We wish to recognize <Name> for [his/her] long and tireless service and to induct [him/her] into the Order of Saint Barbara.
