

Meeting Minutes

Meeting Date: 02/16/24 Started At: 7:02 pm

Old Business:

Baronial 12th Night Location: To use for Fighter Practice, we could use the gym Sunday afternoons for \$50/hr. To add the cafeteria would add \$20/hr. After discussion with a few individuals, we are concerned that people will not show up due to the distance. It might be worth it if we could host a gathering at the same time. We will get back to them to let them know that it will not work at this time. William Ringlancer planning to reach out to a different location that is more central to the Barony; he will have more information next meeting.

Alternative platforms: For virtual meetings, do we want to have a Google Meet account for \$75/yr. Consensus seems to be that it would be worth it, and that we could explore donations to help cover the cost. Motion passed unanimously to get a Google Meet account to support the Barony's online activities.

New Business:

Purchasing Long Tent Stakes: For 20x40 tent, we don't have the longer tent stakes for all of our poles. The company that we usually buy them from is closing up shop. We will probably need a dozen and a stake puller. There are some alternative places that we could get them from: either local blacksmiths or Mountain Forge (where Panther stocks their stakes from), Heinrich/Kollack make them? Heinrich and Kollack willing to make them as a donation to the Barony.

Fall Crown: Considering putting together a bid for Fall Crown; seems like it would be a profitable event. Site we are considering is the Bowmen. The date is November 2, 2024. There is a potential concern that there is no good location at the Bowmen for people to escape the wind and chill; we would need to get sides up on the pavilion. The question arose: would walls be enough? Would we need to rent a larger tent? We would need to look into that and factor it into the cost of the event. We should consider heaters as well. Could consider the site that we held Kingdom A&S, but it could be a substantial cost. We would like to pursue putting a bid together for Fall Crown; more info for next meeting.
