Officer Reports

Chatelain: It's been a fruitful month thus far for this office. I participated at Unevent's Chatelain meeting. Nothing special to report there. Mainly reminders on reporting requirements and discussions on recruitment and retention strategies.

We had 1 reach out from a newcomer that is interested in the Arts and Sciences. He made it to the gathering on the 19th. We had the opportunity to explain some aspects of armored combat; which they are also interested in.

I have also been in contact with several of our repeating demo venues. We are looking at returning to Royal Rabbit May 10th. The day prior to Mother's Day. More on that after the holidays.

We have also been requested to come back to Oakenmist mini-Renaissance Festival the week after Pennsic. This has been a very good venue for us, and I look forward to working with the team to build it up even more.

Finally, while discussing the Oakenmist, it was brought up that we had not heard from the organizers for Maryland Faery Festival yet. After a reach out, it has been discovered that they are expecting us to return for a 3rd year. We just need to find out who they are contacting on our side and get the information we need to set up.

Chronicler: The December Yeoman was sent out on 12/3. I attended UnEvent, where they did a Chronicler 101 course; I have nothing significant to report from UnEvent, but there was discussion around ethical use of artificial intelligence (AI) for the office and discussion about how the Society should stay abreast of copyright conflicts with development tools (e.g., Adobe tools, Microsoft tools, etc.) continually updating terms of use. Feel free to contact me for more info.

Exchequer: We have one check outstanding to the College of Heralds (it was sent some time ago); we will follow up to see where it is at. We will be closing Wells Fargo account and moving to M&T on this coming Friday. \$15,000 will go in savings, \$5,000 in checking. We have a check #2326 for \$100 that hasn't been used (event site fee for B-day; check never cleared). Motion to void check passed unanimously. We need to set a date to do signatures (Wanda, Bec, Mia) for Manchester M&T. End of year will be done once Dec. statements are out.

Herald: I attended Unevent; the main takeaway (especially for non-heralds) is that there is now a system for making submission payments online...no more need for a check or money order! It uses a QR code that goes straight to a Paypal account.

During the office hours at Unevent, I made a comment about a neat thrift store find that I was going to incorporate into a Staff of Office for our baronial herald (then Nest informed me that there already is one...anyone know where it is?) Anyway, a newer herald piped up "Wait, we get sticks?" Which leads me to the point....Not for this University but a future one, I will be teaching a class on heralds and their batons and staves, in period and SCA usage. It will be called "Wait, we get sticks?"

There is a chance that Bill may not be at Birthday; we should find a herald in the event that occurs.
