

Lord William Ringlancer of Locksley & Lady Celest Drinkwater

Unto their Royal Majesties Athos and Alianora, King and Queen of Atlantia; their Excellencies Graham and Freydis, Baron and Baroness of Bright Hills; and to the entire populace of the barony, does Lord William Ringlancer of Locksley and Lady Celest Drinkwater send greetings and felicitations.

We wish to present ourselves and announce our intention to be included in the upcoming polling to choose the next Baron and Baroness of Bright Hills. We have sought the advice of many coronets past and present and present ourselves with a clear understanding of the responsibilities the positions entails.

We are both long-time residents of the barony, having met at Highland River Melees in Highland Foorde in 1996 shortly after we individually moved to the barony. We married in 1997 and the rest, as they say, is history.

Lord William started off in the Society in 1985 in Caid and lived in four other kingdoms before growing roots in Atlantia. Back then you'd find her either shooting archery, working in the kitchens, creating a variety of needlework projects, or playing recorder in the dance band. Upon meeting William, she pursued the very medieval artform of motherhood times three, running the estate and becoming the driving force not only for her family, but also like a stage manager, allowing William to be in the spotlight while she kept everything running behind the scenes. She has also extended her sewing skills to costume many of the Shakespearean plays William has performed in, and to compete at Revenge of the Stitch as a member of her daughter's team.

We both come from a background that emphasizes service to community, William through his chosen careers first as a soldier and then as a federal employee, and Celest as a social worker primarily working with children in foster care. William also provided 16 years of leadership in scouting at the unit and district levels. Celest spent an equal number of years volunteering at her children's schools as well as an assistant to the children's choir director.
